PROCLAMATION

- **WHEREAS**, Missoula's first ever Community Greenhouse Gas Emissions Inventory identified the transportation sector as the number one emitter of greenhouse gases, contributing 37% of Missoula's total emissions, or 333,986 metric tons per year; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Missoula is committed to reducing drive alone commutes from 70.5% of all commute trips to only 34% by 2045 as stated in the 2016 Long Range Transportation Plan. To achieve this aggressive mode split goal, the number of commuters biking, walking and taking transit needs to increase threefold; and
- **WHEREAS**, Missoula In Motion is charged with the mission of increasing the use of sustainable transportation by educating and encouraging individuals to consider sustainable transportation options; and
- **WHEREAS**, when Missoulians choose to travel using sustainable transportation modes, they reduce our collective carbon footprint, relieve congestion, save money, preserve our clean air and improve individual and community health.
