### MINOR TRAFFIC DETOURS IN PLACE FOR RATTLESNAKE SEWER PROJECT

Construction of the Rattlesnake Neighborhood Sewer Collection System began this week and will continue until weather brings about a winter shutdown. Construction this fall will be in the area of Duncan Drive, Parkside Lane, Skyline Drive and Lolo Street.

Traffic detours in the area will be clearly marked. Generally, here's an outline for October:

Week of Oct. 5: Construction began at the intersection of Lolo Street and Duncan Drive and is moving north on Duncan Drive. Duncan Drive is closed from Lolo Street to Dickenson Street. Local traffic is detoured on Redwood Street, Woodland Avenue and Lolo Street.

Week of Oct. 12: Construction will continue north on Duncan Drive and will move west on Parkside Lane and then west on Skyline Drive. The Duncan Drive closure and detours will stay in place, clearly marked.

Week of Oct. 19: Construction will continue north on Duncan Drive and west and north on Skyline Drive. Near the end of the week, the project will move west on Parkside Lane. Duncan Drive closure and detour will remain the same.

Week of Oct. 26: The project will continue north on Skyline Drive and west on Parkside Lane and will begin to move north on Valley Drive. Local traffic will go through the Lolo/Duncan intersection. Paving may begin on Duncan Drive.
