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The Missoula Police Department is accepting applications for its 2013 Citizens' Law Enforcement Academy (CLEA). For over 16 years, this nine-week program has provided Missoula citizens with a realistic view of their Missoula Police Department's activities, challenges and accomplishments.

The academy is open to local citizens, business owners, fraternal organization members and non-profit organizations. It includes an overview of the Missoula Police Department's activities including Uniform Patrol, Investigations, Special Teams, School Resource Officers, Crime Scene Investigations, K-9 program, Drug Recognition Experts and Quality of Life. There are also some hands-on activities, including a ride-along with officers and a training simulator.
