Community Quality of Life Advisory Committee Applications Still Open

The Community Quality of Life Advisory Committee is open to applications from community members representing a range of interests who will advise the City of Missoula, The University of Montana and the Associated Students of the University of Montana on how to move forward on the goals of their Community Quality of Life Initiative. Those goals are: facilitating the development of quality student housing; establishing a program for ensuring compliance with life safety codes in residential rental units; enhancing the neighborhood quality-of-life program; establishing parking alternatives; and engaging in a joint housing and transportation planning process.

Leaders of the initiative are Mayor John Engen, UM President Royce Engstrom and ASUM President Zach Brown.

The advisory committee will meet as needed and commit to a quarterly public forum to give a progress report. The initiative leaders will choose members for three-year terms on the committee, each member dedicated to a particular constituency.
