On January 24, the Missoula At-Risk Housing Coalition will hold Missoula's seventh Project Homeless Connect event. Project Homeless Connect is a one-day, one-stop service event aimed at connecting people who are homeless and those worried about becoming homeless with essential services. Attendees will be able to access medical and dental care, reading glasses, a warm meal, clothing, hair cuts, mental health counseling, legal advice, housing assistance, employment counseling, benefits enrollment, pet services, and more.
