### **Citizen Avalanche Clean-Up Coordinators Call for Volunteers**

Neighbors coordinating post-avalanche cleanup at Holly and Harrison streets will hold a work day on Saturday, March 15, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. They are calling for volunteers who are willing and able to dig snow and clean up yards on private properties.

Volunteers should wear very sturdy work boots and work gloves that will stand up to the hazards of nails and glass. They should bring shovels – flat shovels work best – and sturdy rakes and plastic garbage bags if possible. Please no children or pets. The coordinators would appreciate two hours or a full day of labor.

Their goals are to remove snow that is up against damaged houses, clean up debris in yards and potentially uncover more personal possessions.

Non-volunteers should avoid the area. Glass and nails are hazards to car and bike tires, and volunteers are still working.
