## **Growth Policy Listening Sessions Slated For Week of September 7**

The public is invited to attend community listening sessions hosted by Our Missoula, a community project that will create a plan for potential growth and development in the Missoula urban area. Four listening session times and locations are planned to focus on “Neighborhoods” beginning the week of August 18. The sessions are an opportunity for community members to share ideas on the types of challenges that the community faces and possible solutions from the neighborhood perspective. No pre-registration is required.

The upcoming dates and locations are:

- Tuesday, September 9, 6:30 to 8 p.m. at the Lifelong Learning Center (310 S. Curtis St.)
- Wednesday, September 10, 6:30 to 8 p.m. at the Southgate Mall Community Room (2901 Brooks St.)

The sessions are part of a series of 28 public meetings on the City growth policy project that are being held throughout the community. The City of Missoula’s Development Services, with the leadership of Missoula Consolidated Planning Board, Mayor John Engen, and the City Council, initiated the Our Missoula project to develop the new growth policy. Our Missoula will go beyond the requirements of state law with an elevated public input process so that the new land use policies will be as representative as possible of all Missoulians.
