## 2016 MISSOULA HISTORIC PRESERVATION AWARDS OPEN FOR NOMINATIONS

The annual Missoula Historic Preservation awards honor those who work to preserve and restore the places in our community that lend so much character to our life here. Have you or your neighbor transformed a wreck of a building to a livable wonder? The Missoula Historic Preservation Commission is seeking nominations for the 2016 Missoula Historic Preservation Awards. Nominations are due by March 4.

“This is an opportunity to say thanks,” said Mike Monsos, Historic Preservation Commission Chairman. “It’s a thank you to those responsible for restoring an old house, for designing an addition that is compatible with the historic character of the neighborhood, for painting projects that emphasize the historic architectural elements of a home or historic business, or for contributing to community preservation as an individual or group. Such recognition has been shown to help inspire new projects that continue to make Missoula a Preserve America community.”

The 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Missoula Historic Preservation Awards will be judged by the Missoula Historic Preservation Commission, with the individuals and groups honored at a public, catered awards event during May, National Historic Preservation Month. Projects must have been **completed** in 2013, 2014 or 2015.
