

The following is the Weekly Road Report for the week of August 20, 2017

Street and/or Lane Closures

- 1. North Pattee Street Front Street to Main Street: Full road closure Monday (8/21), Tuesday (8/22) and Wednesday day (8/23). Both lanes of *Pattee Street* will be open starting Wednesday night.
- 2. North Pattee Street Main Street to Broadway Street: NWE will close southbound Pattee Street on Monday (8/21). This may cause full closure of Pattee Street due to the northbound lane currently closed for the Conflux Brewery. In anticipation of Roots Festival, the northbound closure will be reduced to just the parking lane sometime this week prior to Thursday. Full northbound lane closure will resume after River City Roots Festival.
- **3.** Main Street / Pattee Street Intersection: Northwestern Energy may begin work at the intersection of Main and Pattee. One lane of Main Street will be closed at a time. *Full Closure* of Main Street at Pattee Street will occur on Saturday morning (8/26) starting at 5 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. for the River City Roots Festival 4-Mile Fun Run.
- 4. Main Street Higgins Street to Orange Street: Full Closure of Main Street will occur starting at 3:00 p.m. Thursday (8/24) and continues through Saturday night (8/26). Additionally, Ryman Street will be closed south of Broadway Street and north of Front Street during the same period with access to parking lots/garages kept open. A southbound lane on Woody Street will be open for access to the Festival's backstage and for the lease parking lot north of Wells Fargo Bank.
- **5. Kiwanis Street** east of **Clay Street** may be reduced to one lane for a sewer connection.
- **6. Broadway Street Woody Street to Orange Street:** Work is continuing on construction of the Stockman's Bank on this block. Both lanes of Woody and the parking lane on Broadway and all adjacent sidewalks will be closed for the duration of this project which should be finished late this year.
- 7. East Front Street Clay Street to Adams Street: Front Street will be reduced to one lane for construction of the new Student Housing Project at the corner of Clay and East Front. This project also includes the closure all adjacent sidewalks

and possible traffic delays for heavy truck traffic on Clay and Kiwanis Streets.

- **8.** East Front Street Higgins Avenue to Pattee Street: Front Street will be reduced to one lane and sidewalks will be closed for deconstruction activities at the Old Mercantile Building. This work should take approximately 2 years.
- **9.** Mary Avenue Reserve Street to Railroad Tracks: Construction of new curbs and sidewalks has started and will continue for several months. Look for road closures and detours.
- **10.** The Area Bound by 6th/Stephens Avenue/ Brooks and Crosby Streets: A curb and sidewalk upgrade project is in progress. Look for intermittent road closures and shoulder work.
- 11. Benton, Dearborn, and Fairview Avenues between Eaton and Clark Streets and Clark Street between Fairview and Mary Avenues: A curb and sidewalk upgrade project has started in this area, look for road closures and detours.
- **12.** Russell Street Bridge Advanced warning: Russell Street Bridge will be closed for deck resurfacing starting at 5am on Tuesday, August 29th through Wednesday, August 30th. Look for updates in local media outlets.
- **13. Madison Street Bridge:** All four (4) lanes are now open. Work continues underneath the bridge.

<u>Underbridge info:</u> The pedestrian/bike underbridge, below the Madison Street Bridge, will remain closed until the rehab work is finished. **Until that time,** pedestrians and cyclists are asked to please not use the Underbridge during the closure at any time.

Pedestrians and bikers are now able to cross via the newly widened sidewalk in the northbound lanes of the Madison Street Bridge. Additional and nearby, river crossings for bicyclists and pedestrians are available at the Van Buren Walking Bridge and Higgins Ave Bridge.

Park & Trail Closures

14. Riverfront Trail and the Madison Street Pedestrian Underbridge: The trail system will remain open throughout the project with the exception of the trail access via Maurice Ave directly south east of the bridge.

Please plan additional time if you are a cyclist or pedestrian wishing to cross over the river via the Madison Street Bridge.
