


Pineview Park Renovation

Grand Re-Opening Fall, 2009



For your safety...

The new park will include:

- New playground
- Picnic shelter
- Irrigation system
- Tennis courts
- Ice rink enhancements
- Portable restroom enclosure
- Trails and landscaping

Alternate places to play:

- Tom Green Park
- A large open area, for active play and sports, is located on the west side of the Mountain View footbridge, next to the PEAS farm.
- Rattlesnake Elementary School playground is open to the public after school hours and on weekends.
- The trail connecting Pineview Dr. and Mountain View Dr. and the Mountain View footbridge will remain open.

This project is funded, at citizen request, by a Special Improvement District (SID) which affects about 1,700 property owners in the Rattlesnake neighborhood annually for 20 years. The total project cost is approximately \$750,000.
