Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

Expansion of level of service to existing trail network by increasing capacity (widening trail), extending trails, and installing/updating trail lighting. Includes most existing trails (i.e. Milwaukee Trail, Bitterroot Trail, Ron's River trail, Grant Creek Trail, Greenough, South Hills, etc). FY21 request is to complete engineering, public and stakeholder engagement, and develop construction documents. Completing a primary commuter path between Orange and Russell St to achiece goals related to mode share equity and access as well as safety. Meet shared goals with Westside neighborhood regarding CPTED (Crime Prevention through Environmental Design).

History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

In most cases, current network meets the minimum width (10'), however this does not meet the need of users. Enhanced width, trail lighting, and connectivity increases capacity, safety, length of use, etc. This is in line with our mode-split goals from LRTP, as well other adopted plans. This would complete missing sections of Ron's River Trail west of Orange St and to Russell, as well as provide improvements (i.e. lighting and wayfinding) to increase visibility and safety through the corridor. It would also widen to a 16-20' width to handle capacity and use for a downtown shared-use path.
