

LOWELL ELEMENTARY FREE AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM

This program is offered through the City of Missoula at no cost to Lowell students!

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Any Lowell student who is in school during the day - during the hybrid model kids who are in school on that day will be able to participate. You can choose which days you would like your child attend.

Kids will remain in the same pod they are placed in during the school day. Each pod will have 2-4 youth program facilitators.

WHAT TIME DOES THE PROGRAM MEET?

The Lowell Afterschool program meets from the end of the school day to pick up between 5-5:30pm. Pick up location around Lowell School/Westside Park.

Blue Pod Pick up- Amphitheater

Red Pod Pick up – Basketball Court

Yellow Pod Pick up – Westside Park on far side of playground

HOW CAN I SIGN UP?

WHAT ACTIVITIES WILL MY CHILD DO?

Games, arts and crafts, biking, hiking, gardening, sports, field trips will all be a part of the program. Activity schedules will be updated weekly. Each group will have 2-3 planned activities for kids to choose from daily.

COVID PRECAUTIONS

Kids must wear masks when in school building, while being transported in bus or vans, and outdoors when physical distancing cannot be maintained.

Handwashing and hand sanitizer will be available and staff will remind kids to use before/after eating and during transition times.

The program will maintain smaller, consistent group sizes, and we will track participation for better contact tracing if needed.
