ARPA REQUEST: Poverello Center Shelter and Programming

**1. How will request assist in achieving Department Goal and benefit the customer?**

The Poverello Center continues to play a central role in the City's ability to provide short-term shelter, community-wide outreach, food, and access to the Coordinated Entry System; it's our responsibility to continue to bolster the agency's programming and advance the ways in which it can support our unhoused neighbors. We propose to providing this support through funding equal to 1.8 mills. This funding will allow the Pov to expand community-wide outreach that supports the broader coordinated entry system while continuing to operate it's shelter to high standards. It will also allow the City to better collaborate with the agency through two dedicated seats on the Board of Directors. Strong partnership with the Pov is key to effectively serving Missoula's houseless neighbors. This request directly supports Strategic Goal 1 by providing lifesaving services through agency partnerships to one of Missoula's most vulnerable populations--unhoused neighbors. It directly responds to the first sub-item: "Partner with community organizations to ensure adequate shelter for people without a home during the winter months."

**2. What specifically is needed to achieve this goal?**

Specifically we request funding equal to 1.8 mills, or \$211,476. This funding will be distributed to the Pov through a contractual agreement that clearly outlines expected individual and community outcomes.
