Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:

Ron's River Trail currently ends at Kiwanis park, and is connected to Bess Reed park via a series of shared trail/streets. Connecting Ron's River trail east is important to meet the citys goals around climate and equity. There are several high priority sections of Ron's River Trail to create/connect: From Bess Reed Park to Kiwanis park; From Kiwanis park to Van Buren pedestrian bridge; From Van Buren to Missoula College and; From Missoula College east to Easy Street. There are sections where the City has ownership or easements and some sections where land acquistion will be necessary.

## History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed

As development increases east of downtown it becomes increasingly important to connect Ron's River Trail all the way to East Missoula to create a safe and accessible corridor for active transportation.
