## **Sculpture Missoula to Unveil New Public Sculptures in Silver Park**

**MISSOULA, MT** — Sculpture Missoula is proud to announce the grand unveiling of its new **Sculpture Installations** in Silver Park in Missoula on **Thursday, September 11, 2025, at 4:30PM**. This exciting new public art space will debut with **five sculptures** created by artists from Montana and across the United States.

The public is invited to attend the **free unveiling event**, which will include brief remarks, artist introductions, refreshments, and a first look at the sculptures.

The Sculpture Park represents a bold new chapter in Missoula's creative landscape—offering residents and visitors an accessible, free, and permanent destination to experience contemporary sculpture in an outdoor setting. This is a public/private partnership with the City of Missoula through its Parks and Recreation Department, who by providing the space, has increased access to art in a public park at no additional cost to the taxpayer – all funding for acquiring, installing, and maintaining the sculptures is provided by Sculpture Missoula through private donations and grants.

The inaugural collection showcases a diverse range of styles and materials, reflecting the innovation and vision of nationally recognized sculptors. Another five sculptures juried by Sculpture Missoula will be installed in Silver Park in September 2026.

"This park has been years in the making, and we're thrilled to finally share it with the community", said Chuck Leonard of Sculpture Missoula. "These installations are designed to engage, challenge, and inspire."

Located within **Silver Park**, adjacent to downtown Missoula and on the riverfront trail system, the new Sculpture Park invites people of all ages to explore, reflect, and enjoy art.

Sculpture Missoula, fiscally sponsored by Arts Missoula, is a local volunteer group of citizens dedicated to advancing the appreciation of sculpture through education, exhibitions, and public art.
