3. Presentations:

a. Stormwater- Tracy Campbell

i. Recalls that the bid was \$40-50k to complete the plan they had for the slant street gateway. This plan addresses the triangle on the east side of the intersection only.

ii. The sidewalks and boulevards are approved and will be happening at this location next year according to Ben Weiss' 8/12/2025 email to leadership team.

iii. Tracy can help our leadership team apply for the Residential and Community Green Stormwater Infrastructure Grants (westernmtwaters.com)

- grant funds up to \$50k

- requires a 25% non-federal match (Stormwater already paid \$6-8k for the plans, which counts as a match and an Energize Your Neighborhood grant could be used toward the match too).

- Grant applications being accepted through November. Tracy recommends submitting this month if leadership wants to try.

- Other possibilities include Conservation Grants, DNRC grants, Watershed grants

- Tracy will contact IMEG tomorrow to make sure the surface improvements they have planned will still allow us to retrofit a rain garden. Melissa will share the response with the Leadership Team.

iv. Though this only addresses the East triangle, a phased process could lead to addressing the West triangle.

v. Keywords: demonstration, gateway, across the street from the fire station, interpretive signage, arterial, pollinators.
