

Rose Park Neighborhood Council - Leadership Team Meeting Minutes

1. Introduction and Roll Call

2. Approval of Minutes- October 9th, 2025- motion- Carly, second- Tony

3. Presentations:

a. Ivy/ Franklin Phase 2- Brandt Dalen

i. Presented plans for curbing, boulevards and sidewalk.

ii. The plan somewhat resembles a rain garden but does not include the "landscaping" portion in the center of the triangles. There are bioswales fed by curb cuts. The city usually seeds the boulevards.

1) There is a bulb out at the intersection of Marshall and Franklin that is an example of how water can pass through/ under the sidewalk to reach a rain garden and would require removing only a few panels of sidewalk

iii. Each triangle will be improved with 7-10 feet of boulevard and 5 feet (minimum) sidewalks on the sides adjacent to the roads.

iv. The project will be out for bid within the next couple of weeks and should take shape in the fall of 2026.

v. They will try to tie it into the space within the triangles as best they can.

vi. The city will be responsible for shoveling the sidewalks on outer edges of the triangles and mowing the boulevards but they are still unsure who will be responsible for maintenance of that space.

4. Items to be Discussed:

a. Energize Your Neighborhood Grant- Leah & Kevin

i. MUD is on board to help with the demonstration portion of the plan and can produce educational materials from a project in Kalispell.

ii. Need support of the neighbors immediately around the potential future rain garden

Action: Leah will create a one-pager to explain the project and Tony will knock doors to gauge approval- Due December 1st

Motion: For the Rose Park leadership council support the rain garden for the energize your neighborhood grant (Tony motioned, Molly seconded, unanimous approval).

b. Message from Heather Harp regarding applying for an Energize your Neighborhood grant for a mural at Paxson school or another location in our neighborhood.

Action: Tony will draft a response and share with the leadership team before sending the reply to Heather.
