 - a. A neighbor who came to the leadership team a while back presented on the possibility of having a fit lot on the piece of unoccupied land along Mount Ave across from the fire station. She wanted to get feedback from the neighborhood and talked about a survey that the team had put out and reminded folks to take it before they left the meeting.
