1. February 7, 2018 meeting minutes were approved.

2. **Traffic Calming update** – Jeff Miller showed spreadsheets of the L & C Neighborhood traffic incidents from 2006-2016 that Ben Weiss had sent to him. Included were areas in the neighborhood that could possibly have traffic calming circles or other means to slow speeding of vehicles. No calming circles would be able to be used on the perimeter streets, South, SW Higgins or Stephens Avenues. In the ten years, only 24 personal injuries have occurred with only 2 inside the neighborhood.

3. **Bancroft Ponds update** – Dave - Steering Committee was established as an action committee, guiding goals into accomplishment. 7 people attend the meeting on March 21. One of the first action is to place signage in the park. Two naming signs “Bancroft Ponds” to be on corners of 34th/Bancroft and 34th/Stephens, Park Welcoming and Regulations plaques will be placed at all three entrances with “give and take” dog bags dispensers at the Bancroft and Stephens entrances. A small grant was written to help obtain these signs. See Steering Committee Minutes of March 21 for more details.

Small grant application - unanimous vote of support by all members present. Grant is for \$500.00 which will cover all signs. The 2 dog bag dispensers are \$50, which will come out of the neighborhood budget. Small grant is attached to the Agenda for March 7.

4. **MCPS operations levy** for the Elementary and High Schools –A written summary nor representatives from MCPS were available for the March 7 meeting. Information about the levies will be published soon and a representative from MCPS will be available for the April 4 Neighborhood Leadership Team Meeting.
