1. Approved of March 15, 2018 leadership team meeting and April 18, 2018 General meeting minutes. Kathy made motion and Katherine 2nd.
2. Leadership team discussed the needed number of leadership team members. Team approved the increase in leadership team members to 8. Pete made the motion and Paul 2nd.
3. Neighborhood Grants
 1. Mural for soil wall. The leadership team discussed the soil wall on the east side of the roundabout. The public art committee could put out an all call to artists. The selection committee would then pick the artist. Proposals need to be submitted by October 27, 2018. There would be a \$3,000 grant to the artist to do the work. The leadership team has agreed to write a letter in support of the mural and purposed the Upper Rattlesnake Leadership Team do that as well. Currently the graffiti coat on the wall has not been put on. The soil wall will be sealed with the graffiti coat should no grant be given.
 2. Tennis Court Backboard. The leadership team discussed that this issued is not currently on our plate. They would consider supporting a letter from the individual wanting the backboard. The individual who proposed needs to write the grant.
 3. Pete talked about watering the trees and obtaining the water donuts. It is possible to get a grant for those. It is possible to apply for reallocating of funds at the end if the fiscal year. The left over funds could go to the tree bags.
4. Bob Giordano was not present to discuss the Upper/Lower Rattlesnake Transportation Committee Update.
5. There are no current plans for a fall general meeting. The Leadership Team will discuss a spring general meeting day and time as we get closer to that point.
