

River Road Neighborhood Council Leadership Team – January 15, 2020

1. The minutes of the November 20, 2019 leadership team meeting were approved as posted.
2. The winter general meeting was planned for February 19<sup>th</sup> at Garden City Harvest at 6pm. Agenda items and guest presenters were decided.
3. NPF grant update – a traffic signal box painting grant was awarded thanks to Charlie Byrne’s grant proposal. Location is at Wyoming and Russell.

  - a. Overwhelming public support for the clinic at the Food Bank at the City Council. Our city council representative voted against it when it could help those in the immediate neighborhood. The Food Bank and the clinic are things that are needed by the residents in River Road neighborhood.
  - b. Information about the YWCA’s Meadowlark shelter was shared, along with renderings of the property.
  - c. Mullan Area Master Plan will be done similar to the Downtown Master Plan.
  - d. Transportation Department is looking into a Reserve St study.
  - e. Hillview Way townhomes passed and is moving forward in the approval process.
  - f. On Eaton and Mount there is a Catholic Church that will be selling their property to develop affordable housing.
