--Described PNC process

--Al Zepeda owns 2227 W. Central, Zoned R 12, 1 house on 3 lots, Wants to make it 2 lots with 1 house on each so each can be sold separately. Need 5400 Sq. Ft, These lots will be slightly smaller than zoning. Set backs, parking, etc. all meet requirements. Through alley is not paved and not required. Sidewalks are shown on the blueprints but may or may not be added at this time.

### Alderman Childers Update

--Speed Study

--budget is coming

--zoning is happening tomorrow. Public hearing for zoning

--pools open, water spraying

--cell phones by public safety people is being considered

--handhelds are under consideration to be banned, not the blue tooth.

### CS Porter School Speed Study

--DOT did a school zone speed study. Average speed is 42 mph

--study recognized that local council can issue a 30 mph speed limit for the school zone, 24 hr per day or perhaps only during school hours 630 am to 930 pm with signs and flashing signs

--Request Public Services respond to the Speed Survey possibilities

--consider the wider the area for a speed limit

--Do something before school starts in the fall.

### **Update CDBG Study**

--5/20/09 Grant applications complete for 3 Fire hydrants. \$150K came into Missoula CDBG. That means 2 additional hydrants for F2F??  
--2 done based on CIP: Grant / Burlington, Margaret/ 9<sup>th</sup> are done  
--2 for approval on June 1 special city council meeting: Eaton/Sussex and Eaton/Strand  
--1 more hopefully: 7<sup>th</sup> and Johnson also being proposed  
Hopefully we get 5 total for the year.
