- 1. Approve <u>January 4, 2021</u> meeting minutes- Caleb motioned, Jessica seconded, all approved.
- 2. Discussion regarding traffic in the Hip Strip area Gwen Jones
 - --first concern for Hip Strip area is safety and ensuring safe bike lanes, parking is secondary; there is a request for a design proposal for a traffic study of the area.
 - --this entire process will take years, and parking is part of it.
 - --to change the parking as it is currently, will need to expand the Parking Commission jurisdiction and discuss possibility of residential parking commission (permits).
- 3. 3rd and Myrtle update after first meeting Jessica Goodburn
 - --there will be a removal of 9-11 parking spots due to crosswalks; public works will repair the road in the spring, May 1st design, project completed by June 1st; discussion re: seating and where it is still under discussion.
- 4. Discussion of Neighborhood grants Colin Woodrow --concern that the city doesn't have much money and the city can't support the projects that would have high impact for the city; \$6K is the maximum grant currently; a successful grant application must have a performance for community and fulfill the needs and wants of community.
- Findings from Neighborhood Assessment Report Colin Woodrow

 findings show need better communication between all groups; lack of representation –need to have better equity and better reflection of neighborhoods- race/ ethnicity/ identity; renters are highly underrepresented
 - --age- generally boomer generation and older, few Gen X'ers, Millennials and Gen Z's.

- --plan for a workgroup coming forward to build a campaign around what it is and how to include others; how to build more actionable neighborhood gatherings.
- 6. Graffiti Follow Up –Contact info to report graffiti– will be posted update to neighborhood webpage.
