 2. Introductions were made.
 3. History of Neighborhood Councils and Community Forum – Jane Kelly, Neighborhood Coordinator – Jane gave a brief history of Neighborhood Councils and Community Forum.
 4. Mountain Line – Topher Williams, Community Outreach Coordinator – Topher gave a short presentation on the Mountain Line bus service.
 5. Neighborhood Boundary Line Readjustment – Jane Kelly and Jake Gardner – Jane gave a powerpoint presentation that discussed the addition of a new Neighborhood Council, Orchard Homes, and the possibility of Neighborhoods doing boundary line adjustments. Jake made a motion to adjust the Franklin to the Fort western boundary line to Reserve Street and any properties west of Reserve would be included in Orchard Homes when it is formed. The motion passed unanimously with 1 abstention.
 6. Neighborhood Priorities Review – there was a discussion on the background of the neighborhood priorities.
