The Grant Creek Neighborhood Council and the Grant Creek Trails Association are planning the grand opening of the Grant Creek Trail from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. on July 9. The Grant Creek Trails Association will be contributing up to \$200 cash and providing the PA system (\$50 in-kind contribution). The Grant Creek Neighborhood Council will be paying for a postcard mailing to announce the event and printing of two large, mounted posters thanking large donors and detailing the sources of funds for trail construction (about \$850 from fiscal 2015 budget). We will need to pay for a porta-potty (\$70), beverages and ice (\$75) and the ice cream truck with 100 free servings (about \$300). We would like to be authorized to spend up to \$350 from reallocated funds to make the grand opening a success.

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
