I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy to provide guidelines for the use of RMIN's Regional Information Sharing System. RISS is intended as an intelligence source for law enforcement agencies to share information concerning criminals and criminal enterprises in RMIN's area.

II. POLICY

RMIN's RISS is an intelligence sharing database. Officers are encouraged to use RISS to further their investigations as well as to assist officers, from outside agencies with their investigations. Officers are to use RISS for law enforcement activities only and that usage must be in compliance with all laws, particularly 28 cfr part 23, and RMIN's RISS policy.

III. DEFINITIONS

28 cfr part 23: Federal rules concerning the use of regional information sharing systems

RISS: Regional Information Sharing System

RMIN: Rocky Mountain Information Network

IV. PROCEDURES

1. Missoula Police Department Officers are encouraged to become RMIN members, in order to gain access to RISS.
2. Officers are encouraged to obtain and share criminal information through RISS.
 - a. All information entered or obtained through RISS must be handled in compliance with RISS policies and 28 cfr part 23.
