Summary Description and rationale of project and funding sources:							
<p>Missoula's urban forest is quickly approaching catastrophic failure. The rate of dead/dying/hazard tree removal is much higher than the rate of replanting. The passage of the 2018 Open Space Bond allows the City to reinvest in our urban forest on City Parkland and greenways. This project will also help to alleviate the inequity between some of the older neighborhoods with high canopy coverage vs. neighborhoods with lower canopy coverage that traditionally houses some of our communities underserved citizens. Year one, (2020) 78 trees were planted by volunteers and staff. Year two (2021) 100 bare root trees are scheduled for Fall planting by volunteers and approximately 50 ball and burlap trees are scheduled for Spring planting by staff. FY20 and FY21 project expenses were absorbed in operating budgets.</p>							
History & Current Status: Impact if Cancelled or Delayed							
<p>Trees take a long time to grow. If we don't replant trees at a rate equal to or greater than our level of removals Missoula will look very different in 30-50 years. Additionally the benefits received of urban cooling, reduced energy costs and stormwater absorption provide by our urban forest will be lost. Communities with high vulnerability rates and low equity will continue to have low service levels.</p>
