# Neighborhood Council Leadership Teams

The Neighborhood Councils in Missoula play a crucial role in fostering community engagement and enhancing communication between residents and city officials. Established to encourage resident participation in local governance, each of the 18 neighborhoods elects a Leadership Team to represent them. These teams collaborate with the Missoula Neighborhoods office, which provides support and resources, including the management of Neighborhood Energizers and the Neighborhood Grant Program. The purpose of the Neighborhood Councils is multifaceted: to facilitate citizen participation, promote inclusivity, facilitate neighborhood-initiated projects, address community concerns, and advise City Council and the Mayor on neighborhood-specific issues. Neighborhood Councils derive their authority from the City Charter and the Missoula Municipal Code, empowering residents to actively contribute to the improvement and livability of their communities.
