Based on previous design and construction of Fort Missoula Regional Park, this project could amend the master plan for additional lands in the area. Those lands include the previous batting cage site, the City owned 'triangle' parcel between Post Siding and Fort Missoula Road, as well as the gravel pond parcels.
