ROY HAMILTON

- **Missoula Street Commissioner, State Liquor Store Vendor, and Mayor**
- **Born.** August 31, 1891 in Thompson Falls, Montana. His family moved to Missoula when he was four years old.
- **Married.** Lora Hamilton. They

had two sons.

- **Died.** December 7, 1970 in Missoula, Montana.

- Roy and his father operated a dairy farm in the Rattlesnake area for many years.
- Roy worked as a contractor through the years.
- Roy was employed by the Missoula Ice Company.
- **1933.** Roy became the Commissioner of Streets and Parks. He served 14 years in this position.
- **1933-1947.** Roy served as a member of the Missoula City Council.
- **1936.** Appointed as Missoula's 29th Mayor when Mayor Ralph Arnold was elected District Judge. Roy completed the final three months of Arnold's term.
- **1953.** Roy was appointed the State Liquor Vendor for Missoula. He held this position until his retirement in 1957.
